Creating a solid plan for your group presentation will allow more efficient use of time, divide the work more evenly and ensure confidence in your final project. For up to 20 extra credit points, you may develop a working plan to share with your group. Each member's plan will have its merits, and the plans can be combined to ensure a quality final project. For full credit, type up the following information and present it to your group on October 27.

1. Author, title and page numbers of essay
2. Thesis statement taken from essay or your interpretation of author's main idea
3. Theme(s) established by the author. Are these different from the thesis statement?
4. Write a paragraph analyzing the author's purpose. What do you think his/her point is?
- 5. A creative idea or activity that will convey points 2- 4 to the class**
6. Vocabulary the reader needs to be familiar with to better understand the essay
7. Two ways that your group might present/teach these vocabulary words
8. Three questions/ideas/activities that would help your group lead a class seminar
